## **Directions to Bishop Farmstead**

### **From Garden State Parkway take Route 70 West to Route 206 (Red Lion Circle)**

Take 206 North from the Red Lion Circle, past the Southampton Municipal Bldg (On right), a WaWa and a water tower (on left) until you get to a traffic light at the junction with Pemberton Road. Take a left at this traffic light.

The farmstead is a red brick building set back from the road bordered by many trees. It is the first building on the right, a very short distance after the left turn from Route 206. After crossing a small bridge, prepare to turn right into the driveway at the white and green PPA sign.

### **From Cherry Hill take Route 70 East to Route 206 (Red Lion Circle)**

Take 206 North from the Red Lion Circle, past the Southampton Municipal Bldg (On right), a WaWa and a water tower (on left) until you get to a traffic light at the junction with Pemberton Road. Take a left at this traffic light.

The farmstead is a red brick building set back from the road bordered by many trees. It is the first building on the right, a very short distance after the left turn from Route 206. After crossing a small bridge, prepare to turn right into the driveway at the white and green PPA sign.

### **From North take Route 206 south**

The traffic light is the first after crossing Route 38. Make a right turn on Pemberton Road at this traffic light.

The farmstead is a red brick building set back from the road bordered by many trees. It is the first building on the right, a very short distance after the left turn from Route 206. After crossing a small bridge, prepare to turn right into the driveway at the white and green PPA sign.
