### Directions to Jakes Branch Park

**Jakes Branch Park, 1100 Double Trouble Road, Beachwood, NJ 08722, (732) 281-2750**

The park can be reached via the Garden State Parkway by taking exit 80 and heading south on Double Trouble Road. The park entrance is approximately one-mile on the right, and has adequate signage.

**Additional Information:** The ride leader will be at the Jamboree Lunch Stop for about 30-45 minutes. You can leave your bicycles in the bike corral while you explore the festival. There will be an announcement made when the ride leaders is leaving the Jamboree.

The 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Pine Barrens Jamboree will take place at Wells Mills Park. Event highlights include music under the Jamboree Tent featuring the sounds of the Jersey Pines, traditional crafts, nature programs and food.

**SL** – Stop light      **SS** – Stop sign      **T** – T-intersection      **UM** – unmarked, no sign      **TL** – Traffic Light
