### TREES / SHRUBS

**Scientific Name:** *Acer rubrum*

**Common Name:** Red Maple

**Container Size:** #3 3-4'

**Price:** \$20

**Description:** Common in hardwood swamps, this tree grows over 40' tall, blooms in the spring, and can be found with red leaves. This species prefers moist, acidic soils, but can tolerate a range of soil conditions.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*

**Common Name:** Bearberry

**Container Size:** #1

**Price:** \$12

**Description:** A very characteristic Pine Barrens creeping woody groundcover. Small evergreen leaves and white to pink blueberry-like flowers; fruit a red berry. Great groundcover for dry soils. 6"-12" tall, spreading up to 4'. Blooms April to May. Prefers well-drained, acidic, sandy soils and full sun to light shade.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Betula nigra*

**Common Name:** River Birch

**Container Size:** #3 3-4'

**Price:** \$20

**Description:** Medium height tree of wet soils along stream banks, lakes, swamps and flood plains. Young trees and smaller limbs have reddish brown exfoliating bark. 40'-70' can reach 90'. Yellow fall color. Needs acid soils.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Cephalanthus occidentalis*

**Common Name:** Buttonbush

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$10

**Description:** Medium-sized shrub often growing in 1 foot or more of water. Flowers early June to late August. Small white flowers cluster together forming large button-like ornaments. 3' to 6', can reach 15'. Grows best in partial shade; can grow in full shade. Requires wet or saturated soils.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens Periphery*

**Scientific Name:** *Clethra alnifolia*

**Common Name:** Sweet Pepperbush

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$10

**Description:** Medium size shrub of wetlands, swamps and sandy woods. Racemes of very fragrant, white flowers blossom July - August. 3'-8' or larger in moist soil. Prefers wet or moist acidic soil but can grow in dry soils. Sun, partial-shade, shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Cornus florida*

**Common Name:** Flowering Dogwood

**Container Size:** #2 2-3'

**Price:** \$16

**Description:** One of the most charming and conspicuous small woodland trees. Tiny flowers are surrounded by showy, white, petal-like bracts. Bright red fall fruits attract migrating birds. 15'-30' tall. Blooms April to May. Medium moisture, well-drained soils. Prefers organically rich, acidic soils in part shade, but can do well in full sun.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Ilex glabra*

**Common Name:** Inkberry Holly

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$10

**Description:** Midsized evergreen, dioecious shrub of acidic soils. The only *Ilex* species to sucker. 6'-8' tall. Female plant makes shiny black berries. Semi-shade to shade. Prefers moisture but can tolerate dry conditions. Flowers mid-June to early July. Fruits mid-September to November.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Ilex opaca*

**Common Name:** American Holly

**Container Size:** #2 2-3'

**Price:** \$ 16

**Description:** Slow growing dioecious evergreen tree of acid soils. Small white flowers in late spring, red fruit maturing in fall (on female plants) and lasting into winter. Prefers moist well drained soil and a non-windy location (leaves tend to pale in windy conditions). 40'-50' tall. Fruit October to November. Shade tolerant but does well in direct sun.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Ilex verticillata*

**Common Name:** Winterberry Holly

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$10

**Description:** Medium size, deciduous multi-stemmed, dioecious shrub of swamps & forested wetlands. Bright red berries that persist through fall & winter are wonderfully ornamental and good for wildlife food. Fruit mid-September to October. 6'-10' tall. Prefers wet conditions but can grow in dry conditions once established. Sun, partial shade and shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Itea virginica*

**Common Name:** Virginia Sweetspire

**Container Size:** #1 18-24" **Price:** \$10

**Description:** Small deciduous shrub of wet acidic sites. Very ornamental with fragrant white flowers in the late spring & lovely burgundy fall color. Flowers early June to July. 3'-6' tall but can reach 10'. Prefers medium to wet soils but can tolerate a wide range of soil conditions. Prefers partial shade but can be grown in full sun once established.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Magnolia virginiana*

**Common Name:** Sweetbay Magnolia

**Container Size:** #2 2-3' **Price:** \$16

**Description:** Small tree with showy, aromatic white flowers. Semi-evergreen leaves and brilliant red ornamental fruit. Spicy, aromatic leaves. 10'-30' tall. Blooms mid-June. Wet to moist acidic soils. Prefers full sun but tolerates partial shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Morella pensylvanica*

**Common Name:** Northern Bayberry

**Container Size:** #1 18-24" **Price:** \$10

**Description:** Medium size, semi-evergreen shrub found on a variety of sites. Aromatic leaves and berries. Salt tolerant, good for coastal & highway plantings. A nitrogen fixer. 5'-12' tall. Prefers moist soils but is drought tolerant. Likes partial shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Nyssa sylvatica*

**Common Name:** Blackgum or Black Tupelo

**Container Size:** #2 2-3' **Price:** \$16

**Description:** Medium to large tree often found growing in forested wetlands and moist uplands. Scarlet fall color, one of the first species to turn color in the fall. 30-50' with horizontally spreading branches. Flowers appear May to June and are an excellent source of nectar for bees. Tolerates sun, partial shade and shade. Prefers moist, acidic soils. Difficult to transplant once established due to long taproot.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Parthenocissus quinquefolia*

**Common Name:** Virginia Creeper

**Container Size:** #1 **Price:** \$10

**Description:** A vine that trails along the ground or climbs up surfaces with adhesive tendrils. Attractive scarlet red fall foliage with deep blue berries that are a food source for birds. Flowers June-July. 30'-50' tall. Medium to dry soils. Full sun to full shade. Spreads quickly.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens Periphery*

**Scientific Name:** *Photinia melanocarpa*

**Container Size:** #1 18-24" **Price:** \$10

**Common Name:** Black Chokeberry

**Description:** Shrub with smooth leaf surfaces. Found in forested wetlands and shrub bogs. White to pink flowers on smooth stalks develop into 1/4" black fruits. 5'-10' high. Can grow in wet or dry areas. Prefers partial shade. Flood tolerant.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Photinia pyrifolia*

**Common Name:** Red Chokeberry

**Container Size:** #1 18-24" **Price:** \$10

**Description:** Multi-stemmed shrub with clusters of white to light pink flowers followed by abundant glossy red fruits. 6'-10' tall. Flowers in late April. Prefers well-drained, medium-moisture soils and can tolerate boggy soils. Full sun to part shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Pinus echinata*

**Common Name:** Shortleaf Pine

**Container Size:** #2 2-3' **Price:** \$ 16

**Description:** Has 2 & 3 needles per fascicle. This somewhat fire tolerant tree, usually growing on dry sites, is an important timber species. Tiny resin blisters in bark makes it easy to identify. To 100' tall. Dry, acid soil conditions and partial shade.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Pinus rigida*

**Common Name:** Pitch Pine

**Container Size:** #2 2-3' **Price:** \$16

**Description:** The characteristic Pine Barrens tree. Large when grown on good sites and protected from fire, scrubby and flat topped when burned. Equally at home on both dry sites and in wetlands. 40'-60' tall. Likes sunny conditions.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Prunus maritima*

**Common Name:** Beach Plum

**Container Size:** #2 2-3' **Price:** \$16

**Description:** Salt tolerant, medium size, rounded shrub of the outer coastal plain. Attractive white flowers; its fruit is prized for making jams. To 6' tall. Flowers late April to May. Fruits early September to October. Grows in moist or dry sandy conditions and likes sun.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Prunus serotina*

**Common Name:** Black Cherry

**Container Size:** #3 3-4' **Price:** \$20

**Description:** Medium size, craggy tree grows 50'-60' tall and can reach 100'. Cherries are an important food source for many animal species and appear late summer. Likes sun but can tolerate shade. Moist to dry soil conditions.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Quercus stellata*

**Common Name:** Post Oak

**Container Size:** #2 2-3' **Price:** \$16

**Description:** Characteristic Pinelands oak tree 35-50' tall. Full sun, dry to medium soils. Drought-tolerant. Fruits are oval acorns and an important source of food for wildlife. Leathery, dark green leaves shaped like a cross. Durable wood has been used for fence posts.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens and Pine Barrens Periphery*

**Scientific Name:** *Rhododendron viscosum*

**Common Name:** Swamp Azalea

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$12

**Description:** Medium height, deciduous shrub of forested wetlands and non-tidal marsh edges. Ornamental, fragrant white flowers. Flowers early June to late July. Can grow to 12' in width and about 7' in height. Must grow in wet or saturated soils and likes partial shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Rhus copallinum*

**Common Name:** Winged Sumac

**Container Size:** #2 2-3'

**Price:** \$16

**Description:** Mid-size shrub with slightly pubescent stems. Striking rich, red fall color. 20-30'. Likes well-drained, dry soils. Semi-shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Rosa carolina*

**Common Name:** Carolina Rose

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$10

**Description:** Deciduous rose 1-3' tall (less frequently to 6') and spreading 5-10'. Blooms in spring to early summer with fragrant and attractive pink flowers with a yellow center. Attracts birds and butterflies! Best grown in medium to wet, well-drained soil in full sun. Water roots deeply on summer mornings.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Sambucus canadensis*

**Common Name:** Elderberry

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$10

**Description:** Woody shrub that can grow 10-15' in height and width. Produces white flowers with dark berries that are edible if cooked. The plant blooms in the summer and does best in moist soil with full sun to partial shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Vaccinium corymbosum*

**Common Name:** Highbush Blueberry

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$12

**Description:** Medium tall shrub at home in acidic lowlands. A plant for all seasons with attractive flowers, tasty fruit, scarlet fall foliage & red winter stem color. Fruits early July to early August. To 12' tall. Likes moist soils but with some irrigation can also be grown on drier sites. Sun, partial shade, shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Viburnum dentatum*

**Common Name:** Arrowwood Viburnum

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$10

**Description:** Dense, rounded, multi-stemmed shrub with showy white flowers, pleated foliage, and blue-black berries. Ornamental and useful to birds. Blooms May-June. 6'-15' tall. Dry to moist soils. Full sun to part shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Viburnum nudum*

**Common Name:** Witherod

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$10

**Description:** Deciduous shrub with white flowers that attract butterflies and showy fruit attracts birds. Red foliage and blue berries in fall provide ornamental interest. Blooms April to May. 5'-12' tall. Medium to wet soils; full sun to part shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*
