### **Use this information to obtain directions from your location.**

*Leave plenty of time to get to the start location for each day. Arrive by 8:30 am and plan to be on the road at 9:00 am.*

### ***September 30<sup>th</sup>, Ride Like the Devil***

**Starting location:** Historic Batsto Village, 31 Batsto Road, Hammonton NJ 08037, 609-561-0024  
Batsto Visitor Center is located off of Route 542, in Wharton State Forest. The nearest major town is Hammonton, NJ which is eight miles to the west of Batsto Visitor Center. Please park at the back of the parking lot. Thanks!

**Lunch:** There is a Wawa at mile 15.1 where you could pick up your lunch. There is the Patio Eatery at mile 19.4 and the New Gretna Sub Shop is at mile 22.5. You may choose to eat your lunch at these locations or follow directions to the picnic area at about mile 31.7 on the cue sheet. If you pack your lunch you must carry it with you.

## ***October 2<sup>nd</sup>, Atlantic-Cape Ramble (long ride & short ride meet at same location)***

**Starting Location: Estell Manor County Park, 109 State Highway 50, Mays Landing NJ 08330, (609) 625-1897**

The entrance to Estell Manor County Park is located at the intersection of State Highway 50 and Military Order of the Purple Heart Drive. Turn onto the Military Order of the Purple Heart Drive and shortly after it becomes a one way road. Follow the one way road to the right and the softball field parking area is on the right. **Starting Location: Belleplain State Forest, 1 Henkensifkin Road, Woodbine, NJ 08270, (609) 861-2404**

The forest can be reached via the Garden State Parkway by taking exit 17 southbound (exit 17) to Routes 9 and 550 or exit 13 northbound. Highway signs are provided to guide the motorist to the forest.
