## TOUR DE PINES 2015 RIDES

**Sept. 30: Ride Like the Devil (48 miles)** Historic Batsto Village, Leeds Point, birthplace of the Jersey Devil, Smithville Village. Start at Batsto Village - 8 miles from Hammonton, 08037.

**Oct. 1: Tuckerton Seaport Journey *NEW!* (49 miles)** Bass River, Mullica River, Great Bay Blvd (Seven Bridges Road), views of Atlantic City. Start location Tuckerton, 08087.

**Oct. 2: Atlantic-Cape Ramble *NEW!* (48 or 22 miles)** Two rides offered. Aetna Furnace, Head of River Church, Lenape Farms. Start location Estell Manor County Park, 08319.

**Oct. 3: The Bridge to Nowhere (53 miles)** Belleplain State Forest, Port Norris, East Point Lighthouse (2nd oldest in NJ), Maurice River Park. Start location in Woodbine, 08270.

**Oct. 4: Pinelands Adventure *REVISED!* (45 or 22 miles)** Two rides offered. Medford, Kirby's Mill, Brendan Byrne State Forest and visit Pinelands Adventures the site of PPA's new canoe livery. Chili and beer after the ride! Start location Vincentown, 08088.
