 - Saving a master file, resizing and sharpening for printing
- Sending your file to print (profiles, paper types and print settings)
 - Processing bracketed images for manual blending
 - Saving a version to share on the internet
 - Natural HDR processing and a look at Google's Nik filters
 - Artist's proofs and examining your print for quality
 - Flattening, trimming and storage
