This **5th annual program** will introduce participants to a variety of terrestrial and aquatic habitats as various topics in the biological and environmental sciences are explored, including general ecology, population dynamics, community interactions, field sampling techniques, endangered species conservation, biodiversity, water pollution, resource use and biostatistics.
