RESOLUTION 193-2009

**AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF MEDFORD
TO RENEW A CONTRACT TO PROVIDE
UTILITY REPAIR AND
REHABILITATION SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Township of Medford (the "Township") enacted Resolution 180-2006 in order to enter into a contract with Mount Construction ("Mount") of Berlin, New Jersey to provide for utility repairs and rehabilitation services; and

WHEREAS, said bid documents, bid submission and associated Contract entered into by the Township and Mount (the "Parties") allowed for a one year contract with up to four one-year renewal terms, to be renewed at the Township's option; and

WHEREAS, the first renewal term from September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008 was approved via Resolution 162-2007 on September 11, 2007; and

WHEREAS, a second renewal term from September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2009 was approved via Resolution 178-2008 on September 9, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Township has reviewed the working relationship established with this contractor and determined that the prior year's work was completed in a suitable manner; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to renew said contract for a third renewal term and has so notified Mount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Council of the Township of Medford, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, does hereby renew the Contract between the Township of Medford and Mount Construction of Berlin, New Jersey, originally executed February 20, 2007 with all addenda, for the Third renewal term from September 1, 2009 through August 31, 2010 and that the Mayor, Township Manager and Township Clerk are hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary in fulfillment of this Resolution.
