## **EPA, Air Force to clean up McGuire contamination**

Federal and military officials have agreed on a plan to cleanup a contaminated 3,500-acre site at an air force base in southern New Jersey.

But it's not yet clear when the work will start, how much it will cost or how long it will take to complete.

The agreement, signed this week by the Environmental Protection Agency and the Air Force, was announced Friday. It calls for the removal of nickel, mercury, PCBs and other contaminants at the McGuire Air Force Base Superfund Site in New Hanover.
