### HERBACEOUS

**Scientific Name:** *Aquilegia canadensis*

**Common Name:** Eastern Columbine

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Showy pink to red lantern-shaped flowers with long nectar spurs. 2'-3' tall. Tolerates dry soil but prefers medium moisture soils. Full sun to part shade. Great hummingbird attractor. Flowers April to May.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Aster novae-angliae*

**Common Name:** New England Aster

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Easily grown in average, medium, well-drained soils in full sun. Prefers moist, rich soil. Lavender, purple or blue flowers August - October. Pinching back the stems several times by mid-July will help control plant height, promote bushiness and relieve the need for staking. Attracts bees and butterflies. Somewhat drought tolerant. 3'-5' high.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Caltha palustris*

**Common Name:** Yellow Marsh Marigold

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Bright yellow showy flowers atop glossy, succulent, heart-shaped leaves. Flower clusters resemble large buttercups. 1'-3' tall. Blooms April and May. Part shade to shade; moist to wet acidic soils. Can grow in mud!

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Echinacea purpurea*

**Common Name:** Purple Coneflower

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** The popular butterfly magnet. Seeds provide food for goldfinches. 3'-4' tall with pink-purple flowers that bloom from June through September. Medium to dry soils; full sun to part shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Eupatorium coelestinum*

**Common Name:** Blue Mistflower

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Perennial with ornamental lavender flowers - nice border plant. Will also fill in as a ground cover. From 1' to 2' tall. Found in sandy coastal marshes and drier inland meadows. Flowers are attractive to bees and butterflies. Flowers appear from July to October. Grows best in full sun but will tolerate shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Helianthus angustifolius*

**Common Name:** Swamp Sunflower

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Lots of yellow daisy-like flowers. A widely distributed sunflower of the Pines. 1'-3' tall. Blooms September-October. Wet soils; sun to part shade. Great ornamental for bog or pond area. Attracts birds.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Lobelia cardinalis*

**Common Name:** Cardinal Flower

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Pretty herb of wetlands with striking, bright red flowers & toothed alternate leaves. Flowers May - October. Attracts hummingbirds. To 5' tall. Needs wet or moist soil and likes sun, partial shade or shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Monarda didyma*

**Common Name:** Scarlet Beebalm

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Also known as Oswego Tea. Dense showy perennial with scarlet-red flowers reaching out from a central terminal cluster. Very attractive to hummingbirds, butterflies, and bees. Leaves have a minty fragrance. 2'-4' tall. Flowers May through October. Sun to part shade. Moist to wet soils.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Pycnanthemum muticum*

**Common Name:** Clustered Mountain Mint

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Easy to grow, minty aromatic foliage with silvery white tops. Tiny light pink-white flowers in clusters. Great for woodland borders. One of the best nectar sources for native butterflies. Attracts swarms of pollinators to your garden! 2'-3' tall. Flowers June-September. Moist to moderate well-drained soils. Sun to part shade. Deer resistant!

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Rhexia virginica*

**Common Name:** Meadow Beauty, Handsome Harry

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Beautiful Pine Barrens perennial that naturally grows in wet soils and bogs. Four magenta to pale pink petals surround a cluster of elongated bright yellow stamens that dangle like a beard. To 2' tall, but usually up to 1' in height. Blooms in second year of growth, late July through September. Prefers wet, acidic, sandy soils and sun. Great for a bog garden.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Solidago nemoralis*

**Common Name:** Gray Goldenrod

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Slender-stemmed plant with small yellow flowers that arch downward, forming yellow plumes. Attracts butterflies and honey bees. Individual plants bloom at various times, mostly in late summer through fall. 1'-3' tall. Sun, part shade, shade. Dry soils.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens Periphery*

## TREES/SHRUBS/VINES

**Scientific Name:** *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*

**Common Name:** Bearberry

**Container Size:** #1

**Price:** \$5

**Description:** A very characteristic Pine Barrens creeping woody groundcover. Small evergreen leaves and white to pink blueberry-like flowers; fruit a red berry. Great groundcover for dry soils. 6"-12" tall, spreading up to 4'. Blooms April to May. Prefers well-drained, acidic, sandy soils and full sun to light shade. **4 Plants left**

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Cephalanthus occidentalis*

**Common Name:** Buttonbush

**Container Size:** #1 2-3'

**Price:** \$4

**Description:** Medium-sized shrub often growing in 1 foot or more of water. Flowers early June to late August. Small white flowers cluster together forming large button-like ornaments. 3' to 6', can reach 15'. Grows best in partial shade; can grow in full shade. Requires wet or saturated soils.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens Periphery*

**Scientific Name:** *Clematis virginiana*

**Common Name:** Virgin's Bower

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Climbing vine with fragrant white ornamental flowers. Quickly climbs 12'-20' high if given support and spreads 3'-6' wide. Fluffy, showy seed heads. Blooms August to October. Medium to wet soils, full sun to part shade. Has ability to spread by self-seeding and suckering.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Clethra alnifolia*

**Common Name:** Sweet Pepperbush

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$5

**Description:** Medium size shrub of wetlands, swamps and sandy woods. Racemes of very fragrant, white flowers blossom July - August. 3'-8' or larger in moist soil. Prefers wet or moist acidic soil but can grow in dry soils. Sun, partial-shade, shade. **3 Plants left**

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Comptonia peregrina*

**Common Name:** Sweet Fern

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$6

**Description:** Low shrub of dry ground with slender, erect branches developing a broad, flat topped to rounded outline as it spreads. Fern-like leaves & stems have a distinct spicy aroma. 2'-4' tall. Likes dry acidic soils and partial shade. Attracts birds and butterflies. **2 Plants left**

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Prunus maritima*

**Common Name:** Beach Plum

**Container Size:** #2 2-3'

**Price:** \$6

**Description:** Salt tolerant, medium size, rounded shrub of the outer coastal plain. Attractive white flowers; its fruit is prized for making jams. To 6' tall. Flowers late April to May. Fruits early September to October. Grows in moist or dry, sandy conditions and likes sun. **1 PLANT LEFT.**

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*
