### HERBACEOUS PERENNIALS

**Scientific Name:** *Baptisia australis*

**Common Name:** Blue False Indigo

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** **\$1.00**

**Description:** A robust, bushy perennial with blue-purple pea-like flowers. Of special value to native bumble bees. Turns silvery-grey in fall. 3'-6' tall. Flowers April through July. Prefers moist, well-drained soils and sun.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Eupatorium coelestinum*

**Common Name:** Blue Mistflower

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** **\$1.00**

**Description:** Perennial with ornamental lavender flowers - nice border plant. Will also fill in as a ground cover. From 1' to 2' tall. Found in sandy coastal marshes and drier inland meadows. Flowers are attractive to bees and butterflies. Flowers appear from July to October. Grows best in full sun but will tolerate shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Iris versicolor*

**Common Name:** Blueflag Iris

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** This iris has attractive blue to purple flowers and blooms May - July. From 2' to 3' tall. Grows in medium to wet soils in full sun to partial shade. Can grow in 2"-4" of shallow standing water. Does best in full sun and moist, rich soils. Will spread by self-seeding and extension of rhizomes.

**Scientific Name:** *Juncus militaris*

**Common Name:** Bayonet Rush

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Graceful wetland plant at home in shallow water of lakes, ponds, and streams in sandy, gravelly, or peaty soil. Slender sedge up to 3' tall. Flowers early July to August.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens and South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Lobelia siphilitica*

**Common Name:** Great Blue Lobelia

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Like Cardinal Flower but with spikes of blue flowers. 2'-4' tall, flowers July to September. Prefers wet soils but will tolerate medium moisture. Likes some shade but will tolerate full sun if soil is wet.

**Native To:** *South Jersey*

**Scientific Name:** *Rhexia virginica*

**Common Name:** Meadow Beauty, Handsome Harry

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Beautiful Pine Barrens perennial that naturally grows in wet soils and bogs. Four magenta to pale pink petals surround a cluster of elongated bright yellow stamen that dangle like a beard. To 2' tall, but usually up to 1' in height. Blooms in second year of growth, late July through September. Prefers wet, acidic, sandy soils and sun. Great for a bog garden.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Schizachyrium scoparium*

**Common Name:** Little Bluestem

**Container Size:** Quart

**Price:** \$3.00

**Description:** Elegant bunchgrass of eastern U.S. Thrives on dry sites and poor soil. Colorful fall foliage. 2'-3' tall. Likes dry conditions. Sun to semi-shade. Flowers late July-October.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Scirpus cyperinus*

**Common Name:** Woolgrass

**Container Size:** Quart

**Price:** \$3.00

**Description:** A member of the sedge family, a great plant for wet to moist soils with reddish-brown spikelets of woolly flowers. Provides wildlife value in the form of food from seeds and nesting habitat for wetland birds. 3'-5' tall, flowers June through September. Full sun to part shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens Periphery*

**4 Plants Left**

**Scientific Name:** *Verbena hastata*

**Common Name:** Blue Vervain

**Container Size:** 2" Plug

**Price:** \$1.00

**Description:** Slender spikes of densely-packed purplish-blue flowers on tall stems. 2'-6' tall; medium to wet soils. Blooms July to August; full sun to part shade. Attracts butterflies and is a great plant for rain gardens.

## TREES / SHRUBS / VINES

**Scientific Name:** *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*

**Common Name:** Bearberry

**Container Size:** #1

**Price:** \$6.00

**Description:** A very characteristic Pine Barrens creeping woody groundcover. Small evergreen leaves and white to pink blueberry-like flowers; fruit a red berry. Great groundcover for dry soils. 6"-12" tall, spreading up to 4'. Blooms April to May. Prefers well-drained, acidic, sandy soils and full sun to light shade.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens*

**14 Plants left**

**Scientific Name:** *Aronia melanocarpa*

**Common Name:** Black Chokeberry

**Container Size:** #1 2-3'

**Price:** \$6.00

**Description:** Shrub with smooth leaf surfaces. Found in forested wetlands and shrub bogs. White to pink flowers on smooth stalks develop into 1/4" black fruits. 5'-10' high. Can grow in wet or dry areas. Prefers partial shade. Flood tolerant.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**4 Plants Left**

**Scientific Name:** *Chamaecyparis thyoides*

**Common Name:** Atlantic White Cedar

**Container Size:** #2 2-3'

**Price:** \$8.00

**Description:** Characteristic graceful evergreen tree of Pine Barrens swamps and bogs. Bright bluish-green needles. Up to 50' tall. Prefers deep, moist, sandy soil. Small brown cones. Best in full sun.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens*

**Scientific Name:** *Ilex verticillata*

**Common Name:** Winterberry Holly

**Container Size:** #2 3-4'

**Price:** \$6.00

**Description:** Medium size, deciduous multi-stemmed, dioecious shrub of swamps & forested wetlands. Bright red berries that persist through fall & winter are wonderfully ornamental and good for wildlife food. Fruit mid-September to October. 6'-10' tall. Prefers wet conditions but can grow in dry conditions once established. Sun, partial shade and shade.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**7 Plants Left**

**Scientific Name:** *Liquidambar styraciflua*

**Common Name:** Sweetgum

**Container Size:** #1 2-3'

**Price:** \$8.00

**Description:** Shade tree that grows to 60-80' in height. Fall foliage looks like rainbow-colored stars! Prefers deep, moist soils but tolerates a wide variety of average to medium well-drained soils in full sun. Intolerant of shade. Spiky gum balls drop in early spring.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**8 Plants Left**

**Scientific Name:** *Parthenocissus quinquefolia*

**Common Name:** Virginia Creeper

**Container Size:** #1

**Price:** \$6.00

**Description:** A vine that trails along the ground or climbs up surfaces with adhesive tendrils. Attractive scarlet red fall foliage with deep blue berries that are a food source for birds. Flowers June-July. 30'-50' tall. Medium to dry soils. Full sun to full shade. Spreads quickly.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens Periphery*

**6 Plants Left**

**Scientific Name:** *Pinus rigida*

**Common Name:** Pitch Pine

**Container Size:** #3 18-21"

**Price:** \$8.00

**Description:** The characteristic Pine Barrens tree. Large when grown on good sites and protected from fire, scrubby and flat topped when burned. Equally at home on both dry sites and in wetlands. 40'-60' tall. Likes sunny conditions.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens*

**12 Plants Left**

**Scientific Name:** *Pinus virginiana*

**Common Name:** Virginia Pine

**Container Size:** #1 12-18"

**Price:** \$8.00

**Description:** Evergreen tree which grows best on clay loam or sandy loam sites, very shade intolerant. To 40'. Likes moist soil and sunny conditions.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens Periphery*

**7 Plants Left**

**Scientific Name:** *Prunus maritima*

**Common Name:** Beach Plum

**Container Size:** #1 18-24"

**Price:** \$6.00

**Description:** Salt tolerant, medium size, rounded shrub of the outer coastal plain. Attractive white flowers; its fruit is prized for making jams. To 6' tall. Flowers late April to May. Fruits early September to October. Grows in moist or dry sandy conditions and likes sun.

**Native To:** *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

**6 Plants Left**

**Scientific Name:** *Quercus stellata*

**Common Name:** Post Oak

**Container Size:** #2 3-4'

**Price:** \$8.00

**Description:** Characteristic Pinelands oak tree 35-50' tall. Full sun, dry to medium soils. Drought-tolerant. Fruits are oval acorns and an important source of food for wildlife. Leathery, dark green leaves shaped like a cross. Durable wood has been used for fence posts.

**Native To:** *Pine Barrens and Pine Barrens Periphery*

**10 Plants Left**

**Scientific Name:** *Viburnum dentatum*

**Common Name:** Arrowwood Viburnum

**Container Size:** #2 3-4'

**Price:** **\$6.00**

**Description:** Dense, rounded, multi-stemmed shrub with showy white flowers, pleated foliage, and blue-black berries. Ornamental and useful to birds. Blooms May-June. 6'-15' tall. Dry to moist soils. Full sun to part shade.
