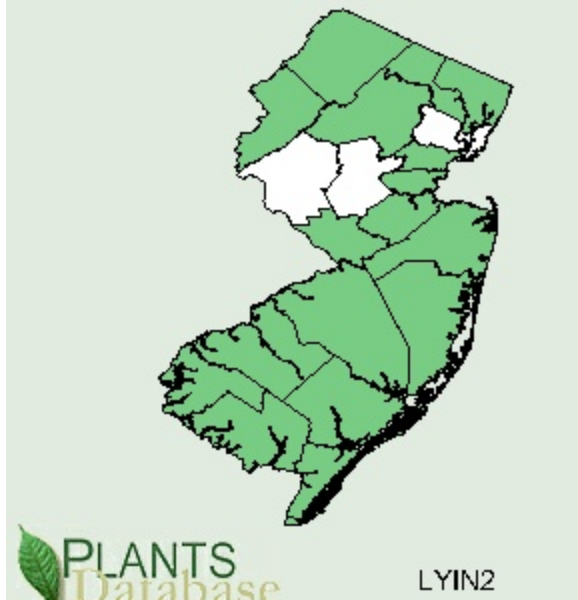

PNR? Scant evidence that the taxon could turn up in the Pinelands. Stone applied the name to material referable to both *L. appressum* and *L. x copelandii*. Later, *L. inundatum* was discovered from GL. -Moore, 2008. The OC record shown by M&F would be within the PB, as shown by Stone, but not within the SPA.
