

Why We're Fighting

This is the view of Allied Recycling's lot from one of our neighbor's homes. What is this run-off doing to our wells? What contamination are we being exposed to daily? What is breeding in those tires? Are the tires protected and stacked to avoid standing water and mosquito infestation? We must continue to battle in order to assure our way of life is not destroyed.

Earliest Date for Next Allied Appearance before Zoning Board June 12, 2014

Judge Bookbinder determined that Allied Recycling did not meet its burden of proof in front of the Zoning Board **and** that the Zoning Board did not explain its vote against Allied clearly enough. This judgment means that Allied must appear in front of the Zoning Board again.

Approximately a dozen neighbors attended the court hearing. We believe that, for such a hearing, this was a large audience.

No definite deadline was given by Judge Bookbinder as to when Allied had to appear before the Zoning Board, but he did make it clear that Allied must move forward.



New Billboard

Southampton Township has rented the billboard at Route 206 and New Road to Allied. The township stated that they could not deny the rental of the billboard to Allied Recycling.

Staying Committed

From the beginning of this fight, we have known that Allied has deep pockets and will continue to take the battle to court, to the Zoning Board, and will utilize whatever delaying tactics are possible. Why? Continued diligence on the part of the neighborhood is difficult to sustain. The hope of Allied Recycling is that these tactics will simply wear us out so we just let this go.

We cannot stop. The quiet of the winter months awaiting rulings by the court may have lulled some of us to put Allied on the back burner. Family commitments and work responsibilities also make it tough. We must continue to fight, to stay informed, to ask questions of anyone who will listen. Photographs taken by neighbors are simply frightening. We have no idea what exactly is entering that yard. We do know that chemical pollution of our environment can happen very quickly but take years to clean up. Southampton Township is supposed to be a pristine, cozy township sheltered in the Pinelands from the toxicity of industrial pollution. If this battle is not won, we will no longer be able to make that claim.
