Special Pinelands Plants Course—Advanced—2014

Each participant will study a site on the Franklin Parker Preserve (Burlington County, Woodland Township). The course is geared for professionals and advanced amateurs.

The objective of the Course is for each student to create a comprehensive, specimen-based list of every vascular plant species present on his/her site. Course work includes:

- 1. Attendance of scheduled monthly workshops
- 2. Field study at your site at least once a month, March through October
- 3. Record-keeping in a field notebook for all pertinent field observations
- 4. Creation of herbarium-quality plant specimens (at least one per species encountered)
- 5. Creation of a comprehensive list of vascular plants on the site

You will have the opportunity to select from a list of available sites. Participants may visit their site as frequently as they wish and at any convenient time. Course participants may work alone or with a partner.

Nine monthly workshop sessions will be held, scheduled **every second Tuesday evening**, **7-9 PM**, **March** –**November** - **starting March 11**, **2014**. During this time, course attendees will have the opportunity to work together on problematic plant identities, field survey protocols, techniques for preparation of voucher specimens, and any other needed collaboration. These sessions will be held at the Pinelands Preservation Alliance headquarters at 17 Pemberton Road (Rt. 616 West), Southampton, NJ, 08088. All work is to be completed by the end of November 2014.
