Directions to Whitesbog Village

From New York City:

Take Garden State Parkway to Exit 88.

Route 70 West to Route 530, Route 530 for one mile to Mile Marker 13.

From NJ Turnpike:

Take Exit 7 to Route 206 South to intersection of Routes 206, 38 and 530.
Turn East onto 530 and follow to Mile Marker 13.

From PA Turnpike:

Travel to NJ Turnpike North and follow above instructions.

From 206 South:

Travel North to Circle Intersection with Route 70. Travel 70 East to Route 530.
Route 530 is located between Mile Markers 33 and 34.

From 206 North:

Travel South to intersection of Routes 206, 38 and 530. Turn East onto 530 and follow to Mile
Marker 13.

From Philadelphia:

From Ben Franklin Bridge take either Route 70 East to 530, or Route 38 East, crossing over 206 onto
Route 530. Follow to Mile Marker 13.
