

Directions - Tour de Pines 2017 – Pedal to Protect the Pines

Be sure to arrive by 8:30 a.m. and be ready to ride at 9:00 a.m.

October 4th, Atlantic-Cape Ramble (long ride & short ride meet at same location)

Starting Location: Estell Manor County Park, 109 State Highway 50, Mays Landing NJ 08330, (609) 625-1897

The entrance to Estell Manor County Park is located at the intersection of State Highway 50 and Military Order of the Purple Heart Drive. Turn onto the Military Order of the Purple Heart Drive and shortly after it becomes a one way road. Follow the one way road to the right and the softball field parking area is on the right. Starting Location: Laurita Winery, 85 Archertown Road, New Egypt NJ 08533, (609) 752-0200

If you are coming into New Egypt from the west you will take a right on Brindletown Road and then a left on Front Street/CR 640. You will pass the Inn at Laurita on your left and then come to the long driveway leading to the winery. There are signs.

Batsto Visitor Center is located off of Route 542, in Wharton State Forest. The nearest major town is Hammonton, NJ which is eight miles to the west of Batsto Visitor Center. Please park at the back of the parking lot.
