Leave plenty of time to get to the start location for each day. Arrive by 8:30 am and plan to be on the road at 9:00 am.

October 1st, Ride Like the Devil

Starting location: Historic Batsto Village, 31 Batsto Road, Hammonton NJ 08037, 609-561-0024
Batsto Visitor Center is located off of Route 542, in Wharton State Forest. The nearest major town is Hammonton, NJ which is eight miles to the west of Batsto Visitor Center. Please park at the back of the parking lot. Thanks!

Starting Location: Lucille's Country Cooking, 1494 Main Street (Route 539), Barnegat, NJ 08005, (609) 698-4474
Lucille's can be reached via Ocean County Route 539, and is 3.5 miles south of NJ State Route 72. **Please park** in the area away from the Diner, which is just to the North of Lucille's building. Additional parking is available across the road at the Warren Grove Fire Company. The bathroom at Lucille's is small so please plan accordingly.

Starting Location: Belleplain State Forest, 1 Henkensifkin Road, Woodbine, NJ 08270, (609) 861-2404

The forest can be reached via the Garden State Parkway by taking exit 17 southbound (exit 17) to Routes 9 and 550 or exit 13 northbound. Highway signs are provided to guide the motorist to the forest.

Starting Location: We will meet at the trail head for the Atlantic County Bikeway located at the Shore Mall/Harbor Square Mall at 6725 Black Horse Pike, Egg Harbor, 08234. You will see Tour de Pines Signs near Carrabba's Italian Grill. The trailhead is at the north side of the Shore Mall parking lot. From Atlantic City follow SR 322/40 (Black Horse Pike) west toward the Garden State Parkway. Cross under the parkway and turn left into the Shore Mall. Turn right and follow the outside lane of the parking lot to the north side and look for designated Atlantic County Bikeway parking.
