

Directions - Tour de Pines 2016 – Pedal to Protect the Pines

Use this information to obtain directions from your location.

Leave plenty of time to get to the start location for each day. Arrive by 8:30 am and plan to be on the road at 9:00 am.

September 28th, Ride Like the Devil (long and short ride start from the same location)

Starting location: Historic Batsto Village, 31 Batsto Road, Hammonton NJ 08037, 609-561-0024
Batsto Visitor Center is located off of Route 542, in Wharton State Forest. The nearest major town is Hammonton, NJ which is eight miles to the west of Batsto Visitor Center. Please park at the back of the parking lot. Thanks!

Starting Location: Tuckerton Seaport & Baymen's Museum, 120 West Main Street, Tuckerton, NJ 08087. Phone is 609-296-8868. The website for the Seaport is www.tuckertonseaport.org - Bathrooms will be open at the visitor center.

Lunch: There is a Wawa at mile 2.8 where you could pick up your lunch - the Patio Eatery is at mile 7.1 and the New Gretna Sub Shop is at mile 10.4. You may choose to eat your lunch at these locations or have your lunch at Bass River State Forest at mile 32.4 on the cue sheet. If you pack your lunch you must carry it with you.

September 30th, Historic Atlantic County Loop

Starting Location: Hammonton Lake Park, Park Avenue, Hammonton NJ 08037, (609) 878-8041

From the intersection of Route 30 and Route 206 in Hammonton, continue West on Route 30/White Horse Pike. After 1.4 miles turn right onto Broadway. After 0.7 miles turn left onto Central Ave., and then a quick right onto Park Avenue. After 0.3 miles turn left into the park. Park in the lot.

Lunch: If you pack your lunch you must carry it with you. There is a Deli at mile 18.7 (follow the cue sheet for directions) and a Pantry Convenience Store at mile 31.8. You must eat your lunch at these locations or carry your lunch to the scenic Lake Lenape Park at mile 34.6.

October 1st, Pinelands Discovery Loop (long and short ride start from same location)

Starting Location: Historic Whitesbog Village, Browns Mills, NJ

Historic Whitesbog Village is located within Brendan Byrne State Forest. The entrance to the village is located at mile marker 13 on Route 530 (Lakehurst Road). Follow the road to the parking lot and general store. Learn more about historic Whitesbog Village on their [website here](#).

Lunch for the Long Ride: **Bring a brown bag lunch and we will take it the picnic spot at Pakim Pond.** We can't return lunch bags to you at the end of the ride so they must be disposable. Lunch will be at the pond by 11:30 a.m. You can also buy a lunch at a Wawa at mile 6.4 – keep in mind there are few stops for food on this ride. Hot Diggity Dog is a fun stop in the village of Chatsworth where you can get a hot dog or sausage sandwich and a cold drink.

October 2nd, Pinelands Adventure (long ride & short ride start at the same location)

Starting Location: Pinelands Preservation Alliance, 17 Pemberton Road (Rt. 616 W), Southampton NJ 08088

Please be careful when following directions to our headquarters. There are three Pemberton Roads that can be found along Route 206. We are located at 17 Pemberton Road – which is also Country Road 616 west.
