HERBACEOUS PERENNIALS

Scientific Name: *Andropogon gerardii*

Common Name: Big Bluestem

Container Size: Quart

Price: \$5.00

Description: Common perennial of open sites. 4'-6' high. Upland, dry sites with acidic soils Full sun to partial shade. Flowers mid-August to late September.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Andropogon virginicus*

Common Name: Broomsedge Bluestem

Container Size: Quart

Price: \$5.00

Description: Common species of dry, open sites. Like Little Bluestem, but leafier and stouter flowers tucked inside bracts. 2'-5' high. Upland, dry sites. Semi-shade. Attracts birds and butterflies. Flowers mid-August to late September.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Asclepias incarnata*

Common Name: Swamp Milkweed

Container Size: 2" Plug

Price: \$2.50

Description: Large blossoms of small, fragrant, upturned rose-purple flowers. Great host plant for Monarch butterflies and hummingbirds. Great for rain gardens and habitat. 2'-6' tall. Moist to wet soils; sun to part shade. Can thrive in mucky clay soils. Blooms June through October.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens Periphery*

Scientific Name: *Asclepias tuberosa*

Common Name: Butterfly Milkweed

Container Size: Plug **Price:** \$2.50

Description: A tough drought-tolerant native with intense orange flowers May - September. Attracts many varieties of butterfly and is especially attractive to Monarchs. Occurs in dry fields and roadsides. Prefers full sun but can grow in part shade. Maximum height 12"-18". Moist to dry soils.

Scientific Name: *Chrysopsis mariana*

Common Name: Maryland Golden Aster

Container Size: 2" Plug **Price:** \$2.50

Description: A late summer flowering composite with yellow inflorescences. Grows to 2' in full sun and well drains sandy soils. Moist to dry soils.

Native To: *Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Echinacea purpurea*

Common Name: Purple Coneflower

Container Size: 2" Plug **Price:** \$2.50

Description: The popular butterfly magnet. Seeds provide food for goldfinches. 3'-4' tall with pink-purple flowers that bloom from June through September. Medium to dry soils; full sun to part shade.

Native To: *South Jersey*

Scientific Name: *Eragrostis spectabilis*

Common Name: Purple Love Grass

Container Size: 2" Plug **Price:** \$2.50

Description: Low grass that produces purple inflorescences. Rarely damaged by deer. 1'-2' tall. Dry soils; sun to part shade. Blooms July and August.

Native To: *South Jersey*

Scientific Name: *Eupatorium coelestinum*

Common Name: Blue Mistflower

Container Size: 2" Plug **Price:** \$2.50

Description: Perennial with ornamental lavender flowers - nice border plant. Will also fill in as a ground cover. From 1' to 2' tall. Found in sandy coastal marshes and drier inland meadows. Flowers are attractive to bees and butterflies. Flowers appear from July to October. Grows best in full sun but will tolerate shade.

Scientific Name: *Eupatorium purpureum*

Common Name: Purple Joe-Pye

Container Size: 2" Plug **Price:** \$2.50

Description: Wildflower of moist woods & meadows with whorled leaves & dome-shaped clusters of pink flowers. 4-6'. Prefers damp soils. Flowers late July to October.

Native To: *South Jersey*

Scientific Name: *Euthamia graminifolia*

Common Name: Flat-top Goldenrod

Container Size: 2" Plug **Price:** \$2.50

Description: Blooms in late summer with a flat cluster on yellow flowers sitting on top of this herbaceous perennial. Prefers full sun and moist soil but can tolerate drought conditions. Up to 3' tall and less susceptible to powdery mildew than some other species of golden rods.

Scientific Name: *Helianthus divaricatus*

Common Name: Woodland Sunflower

Container Size: Quart **Price:** \$8.00

Description: A perennial sunflower of dry meadow with showy yellow flowers. Hardy and spreading. Food source for birds and insects. 3'-4' tall, blooms July-August. Full sun to part shade.

Native To: *South Jersey*

Scientific Name: *Iris versicolor*

Common Name: Blueflag Iris

Container Size: 2" Plug

Price: \$2.50

Description: This iris has attractive blue to purple flowers and blooms May - July. From 2' to 3' tall. Grows in medium to wet soils in full sun to partial shade. Can grow in 2"-4" in shallow standing water. Does best in full sun and moist, rich soils. Will spread by self-seeding and extension of rhizomes.

Scientific Name: *Liatrix spicata*

Common Name: Dense Blazing Star

Container Size: 2" Plug

Price: \$2.50

Description: Slender, erect perennial that reaches a height of 3'-4'. A dense spike of purple flowers appears July - September. Likes full sun but can tolerate partial shade. Grows best in moist, acidic sandy soil. Attractive to bees, hummingbirds and butterflies. Low maintenance plant that may be resistant to deer.

Native To: *South Jersey*

Scientific Name: *Lilium superbum*

Common Name: Turk's Cap Lily

Container Size: Quart

Price: \$10.00

Description: Tall wildflower with hanging, orange flowers. A good plant for rain gardens and to attract hummingbirds. 3'-6' tall. Moist to wet soils; sun to part shade. Blooms July.

Native To: *Pine Barrens and Pine Barrens Periphery*

Scientific Name: *Lobelia cardinalis*

Common Name: Cardinal Flower

Container Size: 2" Plug

Price: \$2.50

Description: Herb of wetlands with striking, bright red flowers & toothed alternate leaves. Flowers May - October. Attracts hummingbirds. To 5' tall. Needs wet or moist soil and likes sun, partial shade or shade.

Native To: *South Jersey*

Scientific name: *Monarda fistulosa*

Common Name: Wild Bergamot

Container Size: 2" Plug

Price: \$2.50

Description: A square stemmed perennial with rosettes of red flowers in terminal whorls. Special value to bumble bees and honey bees. 2'-3' tall. Blooms during summer months for 6 weeks. Prefers wet meadows and moist open woods.

Scientific name: *Monarda punctata*

Common Name: Spotted Beebalm; Horsemint

Container Size: 2" Plug

Price: \$2.50

Description: Aromatic perennial with rosettes of pale yellowish, purple-spotted tubular flowers in terminal whorls. Large, showy white-purple bracts look like additional petals. Special value to bumble bees and honey bees. 1'-3' tall. Blooms April through August. Sun and dry, sandy soils.

Scientific Name: *Opuntia humifusa*

Common Name: Prickly Pear

Container Size: Quart

Description: This low maintenance perennial produces 2-3" yellow flowers in spring and is clump-forming. Our only native cactus. 1' tall. Dry soils; sun. Blooms May.

Native To: *Pine Barrens and Pine Barrens Periphery*

Scientific Name: *Onoclea sensibilis*

Common Name: Sensitive fern

Container Size: Quart

Description: Rhizomatous fern 2-3' tall. Fertile fronds in early July, spore mature in October. Moist to wet soils, shade to part sun

Native To: *South Jersey*

Scientific Name: *Osmunda regalis*

Common Name: Royal Fern

Container Size: Quart

Price: \$6.00

Description: Tussock forming fern that can grow up to 6' tall. Spore mature mid-May to early June. Wet soils, shade to part sun

Native To: Pine Barrens and South Jersey

Scientific Name: *Packera auerua*

Common Name: Golden Ragwort

Container Size: Quart

Price: \$6.00

Description: Self seeding perennial with yellow flowers that produces good ground cover in moist soils. 6"-2' tall, flowers in April-May. Moist to wet soils, full sun to part shade. Attractive to pollinators

Native To: South Jersey.

Scientific Name: *Panicum virgatum*

Common Name: Switchgrass

Container Size: Quart

Price: \$5.00

Description: Very common bunch grass of medium to dry open sites. Attractive fall and winter color. To 6' tall. Can grow in moist and dry soils. Sun to semi-shade.

Native To: South Jersey and Pine Barrens

Scientific Name: *Pycnanthemum muticum*

Common Name: Clustered Mountain Mint

Container Size: Quart

Price: \$8.00

Description: Easy to grow, minty aromatic foliage with silvery white tops. Tiny light pink-white flowers in clusters. Great for woodland borders. One of the best nectar sources for native butterflies. Attracts swarms of pollinators to your garden! 2'-3' tall. Flowers June-September. Moist to moderate well-drained soils. Sun to part shade. Deer resistant!

Native To: South Jersey

Scientific Name: *Solidago puberula*

Common Name: Downy Goldenrod

Container Size: Quart

Description: One of our native goldenrod species that produces anise scented leaves. This plant produces yellow flowers in later summer into fall. Grows well in dry soils with full to part sun. 2-4' tall, important late season plant for pollinators.

Scientific Name: *Sorghastrum nutans*

Common Name: Indian Grass

Container Size: Quart

Description: A tall, striking bunchgrass with beautiful plumes. Very tolerant of most site conditions. To 6'. Will grow in moist or dry soil. Semi-shade. Flowers mid August to mid-September.

Native To: Pine Barrens and South Jersey

Scientific Name: *Symphyotrichum novae-angliae*

Common Name: New England Aster

Container Size: 2" Plug

Price: \$2.50

Description: Easily grown in average, medium, well-drained soils in full sun. Prefers moist, rich soil. Lavender, purple or blue flowers August - October. Pinching back the stems several times by mid-July will help control plant height, promote bushiness and relieve the need for staking. Attracts bees and butterflies. Somewhat drought tolerant. 3'-5' high.

Scientific Name: *Symphyotrichum patens*

Common Name: Late Purple Aster

Container Size: Quart

Description: Fall flowering (September-October) that has dark purple composite inflorescences. 1'-4' tall; dry soils in full to part sun. Great plant for fall pollinators.

Native To: South Jersey and Pine Barrens

Scientific Name: *Verbena hastata*

Common Name: Blue Vervain

Container Size: 2" Plug

Price: \$2.50

Description: Slender spikes of densely-packed purplish-blue flowers on tall stems. 2'-6' tall; medium to wet soils. Blooms July to August; full sun to part shade. Attracts butterflies and is a great plant for rain gardens.

Native To: *South Jersey*

Scientific Name: *Vernonia noveboracensis*

Common Name: New York Ironweed

Container Size: Quart

Description: Great butterfly attractor with numerous tiny, fluffy, deep purple flowers in loose clusters atop stiff, leafy stems. Tolerates a wide range of soils, prefers medium to wet soils. 4'-8' tall. Full sun to part shade.

TREES / SHRUBS / VINES

Scientific Name: *Acer rubrum*

Common Name: Red Maple

Container Size: #3 3-4'

Price: \$20

Description: Common in hardwood swamps, this tree grows over 40' tall, blooms in the spring, and can be found with red leaves. This species prefers moist, acidic soils, but can tolerate a range of soil conditions.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Amelanchier canadensis*

Common Name: Shadbush/Serviceberry

Container Size: #2 1-3'

Price: \$12

Description: Small understory tree that produces white blossoms and edible fruit. Flowers in April/May. Prefers moist, neutral to acidic soil. 6'-20' tall. Full sun to shade.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Cephalanthus occidentalis*

Common Name: Buttonbush

Container Size: #1 6-24"

Price: \$12

Description: Medium-sized shrub often growing in 1 foot or more of water. Flowers early June to late August. Small white flowers cluster together forming large button-like ornaments. 3' to 6', can reach 15'. Grows best in partial shade; can grow in full shade. Requires wet or saturated soils.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens Periphery*

Scientific Name: *Chamaecyparis thyoides*

Common Name: Atlantic White Cedar

Container Size: #2 12-36"

Price: \$18

Description: Characteristic graceful evergreen tree of Pine Barrens swamps and bogs. Bright bluish-green needles. Up to 50' tall. Prefers deep, moist, sandy soil. Small brown cones. Best in full sun.

Native To: *Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Clethra alnifolia*

Common Name: Sweet Pepperbush

Container Size: #1 6-24"

Price: \$12

Description: Medium size shrub of wetlands, swamps and sandy woods. Racemes of very fragrant, white flowers blossom July - August. 3'-8' or larger in moist soil. Prefers wet or moist acidic soil but can grow in dry soils. Sun, partial-shade, shade.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Comptonia peregrina*

Common Name: Sweet Fern

Container Size: #1 6-24"

Price: \$12

Description: Small shrub between 3 and 4 feet tall. Flowers May to August then produces catkins. Leaves are fragrant. Prefers part shade and dry to moist soils.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Diospyros virginiana*

Common Name: Common Persimmon

Container Size: #2 >3'

Price: \$18

Description: Small to medium tree growing between 35-60 feet. Produces yellow flowers April- June and edible fruit in the fall. Many insects visit the flowers and many species of wildlife feed on the fruit. Does well in part shade and both wet and dry sites.

Scientific Name: *Gaultheria procumbens*

Common Name: Tea Berry/Wintergreen

Container Size: Quart

Description: This subshrub is common in the Pine Barrens and creates great ground cover. Flowers in late June-August and produces edible berries in September-October that persist over winter. Shade to full sun, moist soils

Native To: *Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Hamamelis virginiana*

Common Name: Witch-hazel

Container Size: #1 6-24"

Price: \$12

Description: 20-30' tall shrub that produces yellow flowers and foliage in the fall. Well drained soils with medium moisture. Full sun to part shade. Does well in acidic and heavy clay soils.

Native To: *South Jersey*

Scientific Name: *Ilex glabra*

Common Name: Inkberry Holly

Container Size: #2 18-24"

Price: \$20

Description: Midsized evergreen, dioecious shrub of acidic soils. The only *Ilex* species to sucker. 6'-8' tall. Female plant makes shiny black berries. Semi-shade to shade. Prefers moisture but can tolerate dry conditions. Flowers mid-June to early July. Fruits mid-September to November.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Ilex opaca*

Common Name: American Holly

Container Size: #2 24-30"

Price: \$ 20

Description: Slow growing dioecious evergreen tree of acid soils. Small white flowers in late spring, red fruit maturing in fall (on female plants) and lasting into winter. Prefers moist well drained soil and a non-windy location (leaves tend to pale in windy conditions). 40'-50' tall. Fruit October to November. Shade tolerant but does well in direct sun.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Ilex verticillata*

Common Name: Winterberry Holly

Container Size: #1 6-24"

Price: \$12

Description: Medium size, deciduous multi-stemmed, dioecious shrub of swamps & forested wetlands. Bright red berries that persist through fall & winter are wonderfully ornamental and good for wildlife food. Fruit mid-September to October. 6'-10' tall. Prefers wet conditions but can grow in dry conditions once established. Sun, partial shade and shade.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Juniperus virginiana*

Common Name: Eastern Red Cedar

Container Size: #2 30-36"

Price: \$18

Description: Large tree that can grow over 60' tall and 25 feet wide. Grows well in full sun and moist soils but is drought tolerant. This is a dioecious species, meaning it has separate male and female trees.

Native To: *South Jersey*

Scientific Name: *Kalmia latifolia*

Common Name: Mountain Laurel

Container Size: #1 12-15"

Price: \$20

Description: Large shrub that can grow over 6' tall with white to pink flowers. Blooms in the summer. Moist, acidic soils. Grows best in partial shade.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Lonicera sempervirens*

Common Name: Trumpet Honeysuckle

Container Size: Gallon

Price: \$16.00

Description: Slender, high-climbing vine with evergreen leaves. Flowers trumpet-shaped, red on the outside, yellow on the inside. A favorite among hummingbirds! Ornamental bright red berries in fall. Great for trellis or wall climbing. 3'-20' long. Blooms March through June. Sun to part shade; moist soils preferred.

Scientific Name: *Magnolia virginiana*

Common Name: Sweetbay Magnolia

Container Size: #2 12-36"

Price: \$18

Description: Small tree with showy, aromatic white flowers. Semi-evergreen leaves and brilliant red ornamental fruit. Spicy, aromatic leaves. 10'-30' tall. Blooms mid-June. Wet to moist acidic soils. Prefers full sun but tolerates partial shade.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Parthenocissus quinquefolia*

Common Name: Virginia Creeper

Container Size: #1

Price: \$10

Description: A vine that trails along the ground or climbs up surfaces with adhesive tendrils. Attractive scarlet red fall foliage with deep blue berries that are a food source for birds. Flowers June-July. 30'-50' tall. Medium to dry soils. Full sun to full shade. Spreads quickly.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens Periphery*

Scientific Name: *Photinia melanocarpa*

Container Size: #1 18-24"

Price: \$12

Common Name: Black Chokeberry

Description: Shrub with smooth leaf surfaces. Found in forested wetlands and shrub bogs. White to pink flowers on smooth stalks develop into 1/4" black fruits. 5'-10' high. Can grow in wet or dry areas. Prefers partial shade. Flood tolerant.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Pinus echinata*

Common Name: Shortleaf Pine

Container Size: #2 2-3'

Price: \$18

Description: Has 2 & 3 needles per fascicle. This somewhat fire tolerant tree, usually growing on dry sites, is an important timber species. Tiny resin blisters in bark makes it easy to identify. To 100' tall. Dry, acid soil conditions and partial shade.

Native To: *Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Pinus rigida*

Common Name: Pitch Pine

Container Size: #2 2-3'

Price: \$18

Description: The characteristic Pine Barrens tree. Large when grown on good sites and protected from fire, scrubby and flat topped when burned. Equally at home on both dry sites and in wetlands. 40'-60' tall. Likes sunny conditions.

Native To: *Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Prunus maritima*

Common Name: Beach Plum

Container Size: #2

Price: \$18

Description: Salt tolerant, medium size, rounded shrub of the outer coastal plain. Attractive white flowers; its fruit is prized for making jams. To 6' tall. Flowers late April to May. Fruits early September to October. Grows in moist or dry sandy conditions and likes sun.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Rosa carolina*

Common Name: Carolina Rose

Container Size: #1 18-24" **Price:** \$12

Description: Deciduous rose 1-3' tall (less frequently to 6') and spreading 5-10'. Blooms in spring to early summer with fragrant and attractive pink flowers with a yellow center. Attracts birds and butterflies! Best grown in medium to wet, well-drained soil in full sun. Water roots deeply on summer mornings.

Native To: *South Jersey*

Scientific Name: *Vaccinium corymbosum*

Common Name: Highbush Blueberry

Container Size: #1 6-24" **Price:** \$12

Description: Medium tall shrub at home in acidic lowlands. A plant for all seasons with attractive flowers, tasty fruit, scarlet fall foliage & red winter stem color. Fruits early July to early August. To 12' tall. Likes moist soils but with some irrigation can also be grown on drier sites. Sun, partial shade, shade.

Native To: *South Jersey and Pine Barrens*

Scientific Name: *Viburnum dentatum*

Common Name: Arrowwood Viburnum

Container Size: #1 18-24" **Price:** \$12

Description: Dense, rounded, multi-stemmed shrub with showy white flowers, pleated foliage, and blue-black berries. Ornamental and useful to birds. Blooms May-June. 6'-15' tall. Dry to moist soils. Full sun to part shade.
