

Directions - Tour de Pines 2019

Be sure to arrive by 8:30 a.m. and be ready to ride at 9:00 a.m.

October 2nd, Blueberry Fields Forever (long ride & short ride meet at same location)

Starting Location: White Horse Winery, 106 Hall Street, Hammonton NJ 08037

White Horse Winery is a lovely spot in a rural area. We will be parking in the field surrounded by split rail fence. There will be signs for parking. The tasting room opens at noon so please visit the winery after your ride and enjoy what they have to offer. Please thank them for hosting the Tour de Pines!

Starting Location: Laurita Winery, GPS: 85 Archertown Road, New Egypt NJ 08533

If you are coming into New Egypt from the west you will take a right on Brindletown Road and then a left on Front Street/CR 640. You will pass the Inn at Laurita on your left and then come to the long driveway leading to the winery. There are signs. Visit the winery after your ride and enjoy a tasting!

October 4th, Atlantic-Cape Ramble

Starting Location: Estell Manor County Park, Mays Landing NJ 08330.

The main entrance to Estell Manor Park is 3.5 miles south of Mays Landing on State Highway 50. Pull in the main entrance towards the Warren E. Fox Nature center but make a right on the Military Order of the Purple Heart Drive, which is a one-way loop around the park.
