## SUPPLEMENTAL:

The matter is remanded to the New Jersey Pinelands Commission (Commission) for reconsideration of its approval of the South Jersey Gas (SJG) pipeline project in light of the decision by R.C. Cape May Holdings, LLC, not to re-fire the B.L. England plant with natural gas. We reject SJG's argument that we should review the Commission's decision, as it pertains to the so-called Reliability Line, and not remand the matter to the Commission. We also reject the contentions of New Jersey Sierra Club (SC) and the Pinelands Preservation Alliance (PPA) that we should not remand and decide the appeal challenging the procedures approved in Resolution No. PC4-16-42. If the SC and the PPA are aggrieved by the Commission's decision on remand and the Commission applies the procedures it has previously approved, SC and PPA may renew their challenges to those procedures. We do not retain jurisdiction. Accordingly, the appeals docketed as A-002015-16, A-005055-16, and A-003310-16 are dismissed.
