LATE SPRING / EARLY SUMMER

Lettuce, Kale, Cucumbers, Summer Squash, Zucchini, Bok Choy, Collard Greens, Spinach, Beans, Carrots, Beets, Swiss Chard, Cabbage, Chinese Cabbage, Fennel, Peas, Scallions, Leeks, Salad Turnips, Radishes, Rhubarb, Parsley, Dill, 'Cutting' Celery, Perennial Herbs, Cut Flowers

MID-SUMMER

Sweet Onions, Beans, Slicing Tomatoes, Cherry Tomatoes, Heirloom Tomatoes, Tomatillos, 'Husk Cherries'; Eggplant, Okra, Bell Peppers, Italia Sweet Peppers, Hot Peppers, Garlic Scapes, Potatoes, Blackberries, Melons, Bok Choy, Cabbage, Parsley, Dill, Cilantro, Basil, Perennial Herbs, Lettuce, Kale, Mixed Greens, Cut Flowers

LATE-SUMMER / FALL

U-PICK

Some of the crops will be u-pick (about 10% of your total share). These include crops like flowers, blackberries, cherry tomatoes, peas and beans. The crops will be clearly marked and we will provide containers for you. If you are physically unable to do u-pick let us know and we will find help for you.

The actual list will include even more crops AND there will often be many varieties within each crop i.e., cucumbers – slicing cucumbers, pickling cucumbers, white 'kirby' cucumbers etc.! And we value your feedback to help guide our future crop plans. We have been planting Blueberries and Asian Pears which will be a part of the CSA soon! And we will add more crops to this list as we continue to grow.

BULK PRODUCE

If we have a surplus of a crop we will offer it for sale at wholesale prices to CSA members who want to do some stocking up. This might include pickling cucumbers, sauce tomatoes, or fall cabbage for making sauerkraut!

We also anticipate offering items from our farm and other local farms such as eggs, honey, jams, tomato sauce and so on. Stay tuned for more details!
